CONDITIONAL CLAUSES – IF CLAUSES (POGOJNI ODVISNIKI)

There are three types of If clauses.

Type 0: Zero conditional (if- present tense, present tense)

If I feel hot, I take off my coat. Če mi je vroče, slečem plašč.

V if stavku je present tense, v glavnem stavku je present tense. If stavek v tem primeru ne izraža pogoja.

Type 1: First Conditional (if- present simple, will)

I will wait here If you come quickly. Počakal bom tukaj, če boš prišel hitro.

V if stavku je present simple, v glavnem je will.

Ta pogojni odvisnik izraža pogoj. Če bo ta pogoj izpolnjen, se bo dejanje v glavnem stavku izpolnilo. (prihodnost)

Type 2: Second Conditional (if-past tense, would)

If you took a taxi, you would get there in time. Če boš vzel taksi, boš prišel tja pravočasno. (sedanjost, prihodnost)

V if stavku je past tense, v odvisnem stavku would.

Ta pogojni odvisnik izraža pogoj. Uresničitev pogoja je možna, čeprav ni verjetna.

If v Second Conditional izraža lahko tudi neverjeten pogoj:

If I were you, I would buy this dress. Če bi bil ti , bi kupil to obleko.
